We, _____ (student) and _____ (parent/guardian), understand that the Salem R-80 School District will provide transportation and pay tuition for attendance at Rolla Technical Institute/Rolla Technical Center (RTI/RTC) as long as the following conditions are met. Failure to meet these conditions could result in removal from RTI/RTC. If a student is removed from RTI/RTC during the semester, he or she will not receive any credit for RTI/RTC. **This form is due back to Dr. Snitker by March 1st, 2022.**

- 1.) Maintain a grade of "C" or 2.0 GPA in RTI/RTC classes, as well as classes at Salem High School. Student progress will be reviewed each **week**. A student not maintaining a grade of "C" or 2.0 GPA or better at semester will be removed from the program immediately.
- 2.) Maintain appropriate behavior on the bus.
 - a.) Fighting on the bus or any other Safe Schools Violation will result in immediate removal from the program.
 - b.) Students who miss the RTI bus are NOT allowed to drive to RTI/RTC.
 - c.) If a student misses the RTI bus, he/she is expected to remain at Salem High School. The student will be placed in the office or library until the beginning of 5th Hour.
- 3.) Upon return to the high school, RTI/RTC students are NOT TO ROAM THE HALLWAYS OR DISRUPT CLASSES. If there is extra time upon their return, all RTI/RTC students should be in the library until the start of 5th Hour.
- 4.) If a student is suspended at Salem High School or at RTI/RTC, the suspension will be in effect at both schools. The discipline will be equivalent in both buildings. Furthermore, if a student violates the Safe Schools Act, they will be removed from the program immediately.
- 5.) Students are expected to ride the designated Salem R-80 school bus both to and from RTI/RTC. The bus leaves at 8:10 AM and returns at approximately 11:40 AM. STUDENTS MAY NOT DRIVE TO RTI/RTC UNLESS THE PROPER PAPERWORK HAS BEEN FILED WITH THE HIGH SCHOOL OFFICE. IF THE NEED ARISES, A PARENT MAY DRIVE THEIR CHILD TO RTI/RTC IF THE OFFICE IS NOTIFIED OF THIS IN ADVANCE. IF A STUDENT HAS AN APPOINTMENT IN ROLLA AND NEEDS TO DRIVE, APPROVAL MUST BE OBTAINED PRIOR TO THE DAY OF THE APPOINTMENT. STUDENTS WHO HAVE PERMISSION TO DRIVE TO RTI/RTC CANNOT HAVE ANY OTHER STUDENTS RIDE WITH THEM. FAILURE TO ABIDE BY THESE RULES WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE REMOVAL FROM RTI/RTC.
- 6.) If you are absent from school, upon your return you must check in at the office to verify your absence prior to getting on the bus.
- 7.) Since Salem R-80 is paying tuition (\$2914.00 per student) to attend RTI/RTC, good attendance is essential. The attendance office will complete weekly reviews of attendance. Any student who misses more than 8 days at either RTI/RTC or his/her classes at Salem High School, will be denied credit in their classes. The student can appeal the denial of credits to Dr. Snitker and the Attendance Policy Committee consisting of a principal, a counselor, and 3 teachers. The student will be provided the appeal process when the student accrues more than 8 absences.
