REGISTRATION

**ALL STUDENTS** must attend registration in August to receive their schedules and locker assignments. A parent or guardian must also attend and complete all district required enrollment forms.

Students will receive their locker assignments only upon returning ALL completed registration forms.

**OPEN HOUSE**

**PARKING**

Vehicles that are driven to school must have a properly displayed parking tag. Tags may be purchased during registration for \$5.00. Students and parents will be asked to sign an agreement, and to provide their license plate number and vehicle make and model.

\*Missouri State Law requires the immunization of all school children. Students must be immunized against diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, polio, measles, mumps, rubella, and hepatitis B (3 doses, grades 7-12), unless an exemption has been signed by a physician or parent and filed with the school. ALL students must present proof of compliance with the immunization rule by the first day of school, but are encouraged to bring records on registration day. This applies to all students, including transfer students. The state of Missouri requires all students to receive one dose of the Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria, and acellular pertussis) and one dose of the MCV (meningitis) vaccine before entering the 8<sup>th</sup> grade. A 2<sup>nd</sup> dose of the MCV (meningitis) will be required prior to entering 12<sup>th</sup> grade. **NO ONE** will start school if immunizations are not up-to-date, or if an exemption has not been provided. If you have any questions regarding immunizations, please contact your child's school building nurse.

\*\*Dent County Health Center (DCHC) will be on the High School campus on Tuesday, August 10<sup>th</sup>, to give the required meningitis immunization to any senior who has not yet received their 2<sup>nd</sup> dose. A consent form, which will be available in the registration packet, will need to be filled out and signed by a parent. Consent forms are also available at DCHC. No student will be allowed to receive the immunization without a consent form signed by a parent/legal guardian.
