Sophomores and Juniors,

We will be giving an ACT test at Salem High School on April 5th, 2022. Sign ups for this will be with Mrs Plank in the front office. The fee is \$40 to be paid when you sign up for the test. If you plan to take a Math or English class for dual credit next year, you will need to have the appropriate ACT score before being able to apply for dual credit starting next year. The deadline for sign up will be next Friday February 4th. Please see the Counselors if you have any questions or concerns.

You need to stop by the counseling office to check the spelling of your name for your diploma.
